

SK Tax Reinstatement of Tax Exemption

On February 26, 2018 the Province of Saskatchewan announced its intention to reinstate the tax exemption that previously applied to some insurance products; retroactive to August 1, 2017.

We believe in keeping this essential protection affordable, and support this change and direction.

This means that policyholders will be entitled to a refund/credit for taxes paid on their EDGE insurance premiums for all our products, except Travel Plus. The refund/credit process involves many policyholder accounts and collaboration with the Saskatchewan Ministry of Finance, and we are working to update our systems and processes to accommodate this change as quickly as possible.

Cessation of Tax Charges

We will cease charging tax on all except Travel Plus product, effective with the May 1st billings.

Refund/Credit of Taxes Paid

The refund/credit process involves a large number of policyholder accounts, and we are making every effort to process these refund credits as soon as possible. The credit for taxes paid from August 1, 2017 to April 30, 2018 will appear as an adjustment **credit** to the monthly premium in the month processed. For any cancelled policies, a refund will be provided in the month processed.
